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## Homophone

- 'Homo' means 'Same'
- 'Phone' means 'Sound'

#### **Explanation**

- Different Spelling
- Different Meaning
- Same pronunciation

#### **Examples**

Hear and Here, Gate and Get, Site and Sight, Seen and Scene, etc.

## Homonym

- 'Homo' means 'Same'
- 'Nym' means 'Name'

#### **Explanation**

- Same Spelling
- Same Pronunciation
- Different Meaning

#### **Examples**

• Cricket and Cricket, Rose and Rose, Pole and Pole, Bat and Bat etc.

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□ The <u>bear</u> cannot <u>bear</u> the <u>beer</u>. [Homophone and Homonym]

## Homograph

- 'Homo' means 'Same'
- 'Graph' means 'Writing'

#### **Explanation**

- Different Pronunciation
- Different Meaning
- Same Spelling


#### **Examples**

Excuse: (verb, [s] sounds like /z/)

Excuse: (noun, [s] sounds like /s/)

OBject: (noun) a thing

obJECT: (verb) to voice disagreement
